Active Travel England (ATE) provided a response on the above planning application on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Following an initial review of the planning application documents, it was determined that the proposed use of the site would be unlikely to generate a significant number of active travel movements such that we issued our 'no comment' template response.

However, it has been brought to our attention that the proposed access into the site will cross Public Bridleway No. 21 but also that this has already been highlighted by the Definitive Map team at Cambridgeshire County Council. ATE supports the comments of the Definitive Map team in that details of this crossing, to include prioritisation, surfacing and signage, should be submitted and agreed with the County Council to uphold the safety of users of the bridleway.
