Mr Ed Fosker,

I am writing about the planning application DC/23/1999/FUL – Land Rear of Beechwood and Albany House Hill Crescent Haverhill Suffolk.

I have recently found out through the Haverhill Echo that a planning application has been put forward on the land that borders my plot. I was quite surprised to find out this way rather than a planning letter being sent out and displayed locally.

I have reviewed the application and would like to object to the current plans for the reasons below.

Wratting road is in my view a desirable part of Haverhill and this planning application is not in keeping with the rest of the plots.

There have been two previous submitted plans put forward to this plot. Both of which were for one single dwelling. With there being three dwellings, it would increase the noise pollution, car traffic and with their only being one single space put aside for visitors this could mean cars being parked or reversing onto one of the busiest roads in Haverhill.

I understand that if a single dwelling was built, there would be a loss of privacy but with there being three gardens the lack of privacy has significantly increased for Covert View (Wratting Road), Sagittaria and Beechwood (Hill Crescent).

I understand Haverhill is a growing town but with all the other housing developments currently underway is it necessary for another three, three-bedroom houses to be built?
