Following the meeting of the planning committee on 5th December 2023, Haverhill Town Council wish to raise an OBJECTION on planning application CCC/23/110/FUL – Farm based anaerobic digestion renewable energy facility at Land at Streetly Hall Farm, Webbs Road, West Wickham.

Traffic

The addition of slow-moving tractors and large HGV's accessing the A1307 would be dangerous, despite the safety improvements being delivered by the GCP. These vehicles will also need turn right to access the proposed entrance, causing a potential risk on the A1307.

Impact of increased volume of traffic through surrounding villages

Impact of Increased volume of traffic on the A1307 and large HGV's through Haverhill.

Accumulative impact of increased traffic from both this application and that of the Anaerobic Digester proposed at Spring Farm

Environmental Impact

Increase of volume traffic carrying waste being transported through Haverhill.

Smells arising from fruit and sugar beet pulp which will affect nearby residents

Ground water leaks and risk of pollution and contamination from liquid digestate getting into the water table

Crops being grown on their own land, taking land out of food production.

This is a protected public bridleway and consideration must be given to the negative impact on wildlife, walkers, cyclists and horse riders that frequent this bridleway.
