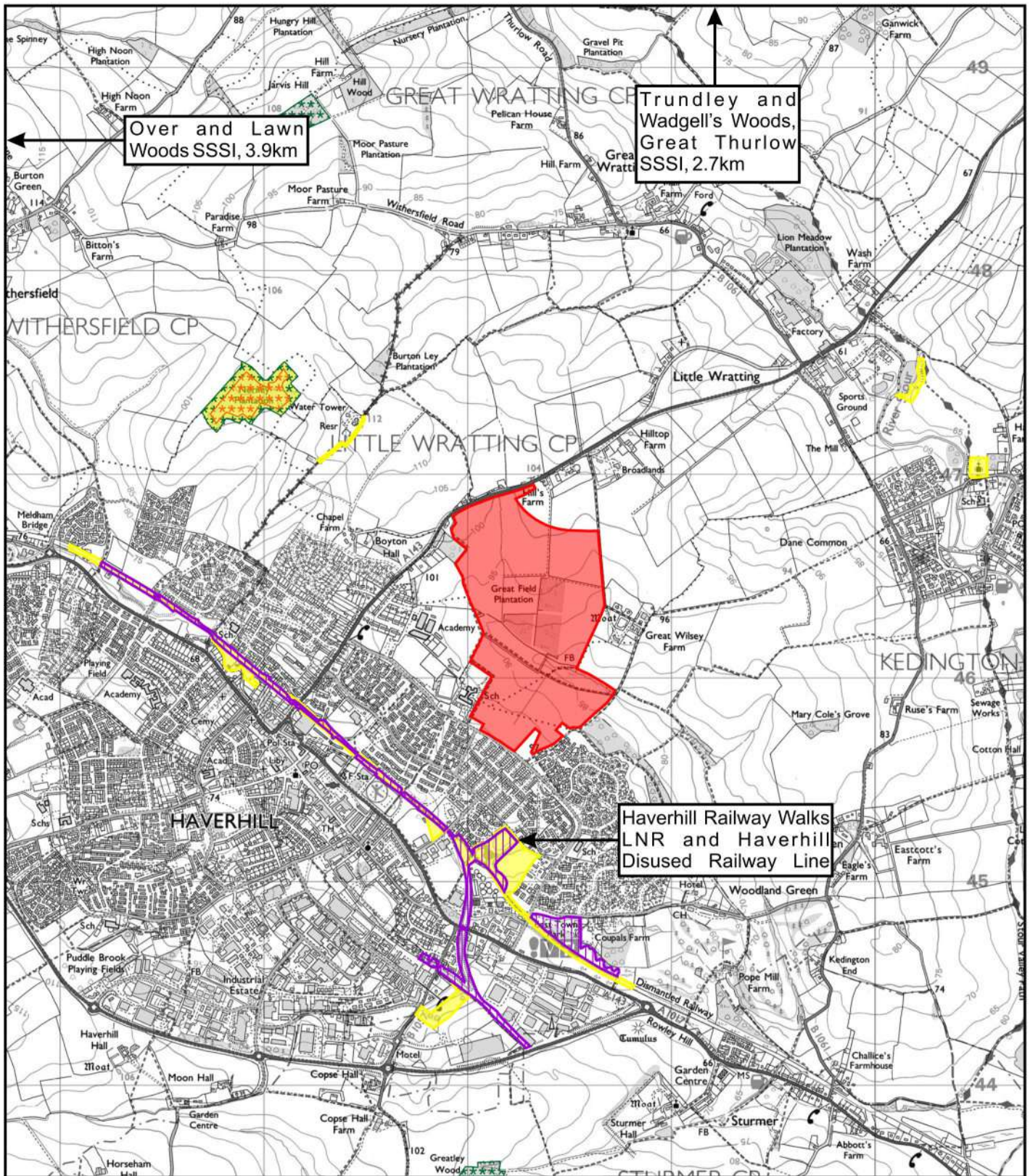

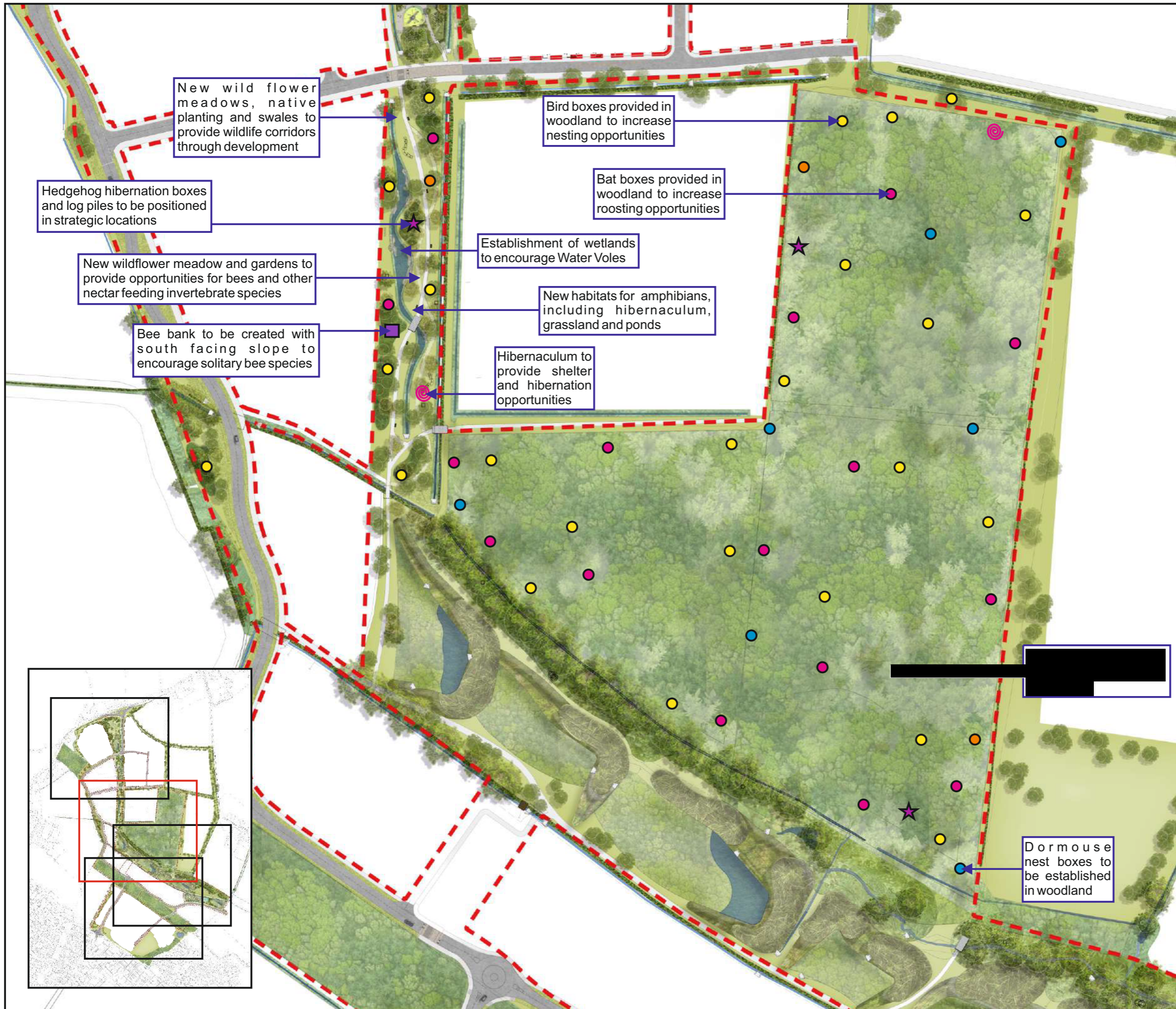

New wild flower meadows, native planting and swales to provide wildlife corridors through development

Hedgehog hibernation boxes and log piles to be positioned in strategic locations

New wildflower meadow and gardens to provide opportunities for bees and other nectar feeding invertebrate species

Bee bank to be created with south facing slope to encourage solitary bee species

Bird boxes provided in woodland to increase nesting opportunities

Bat boxes provided in woodland to increase roosting opportunities

Establishment of wetlands to encourage Water Voles








New habitats for amphibians, including hibernaculum, grassland and ponds

Hibernaculum to provide shelter and hibernation opportunities



Dormouse nest boxes to be established in woodland

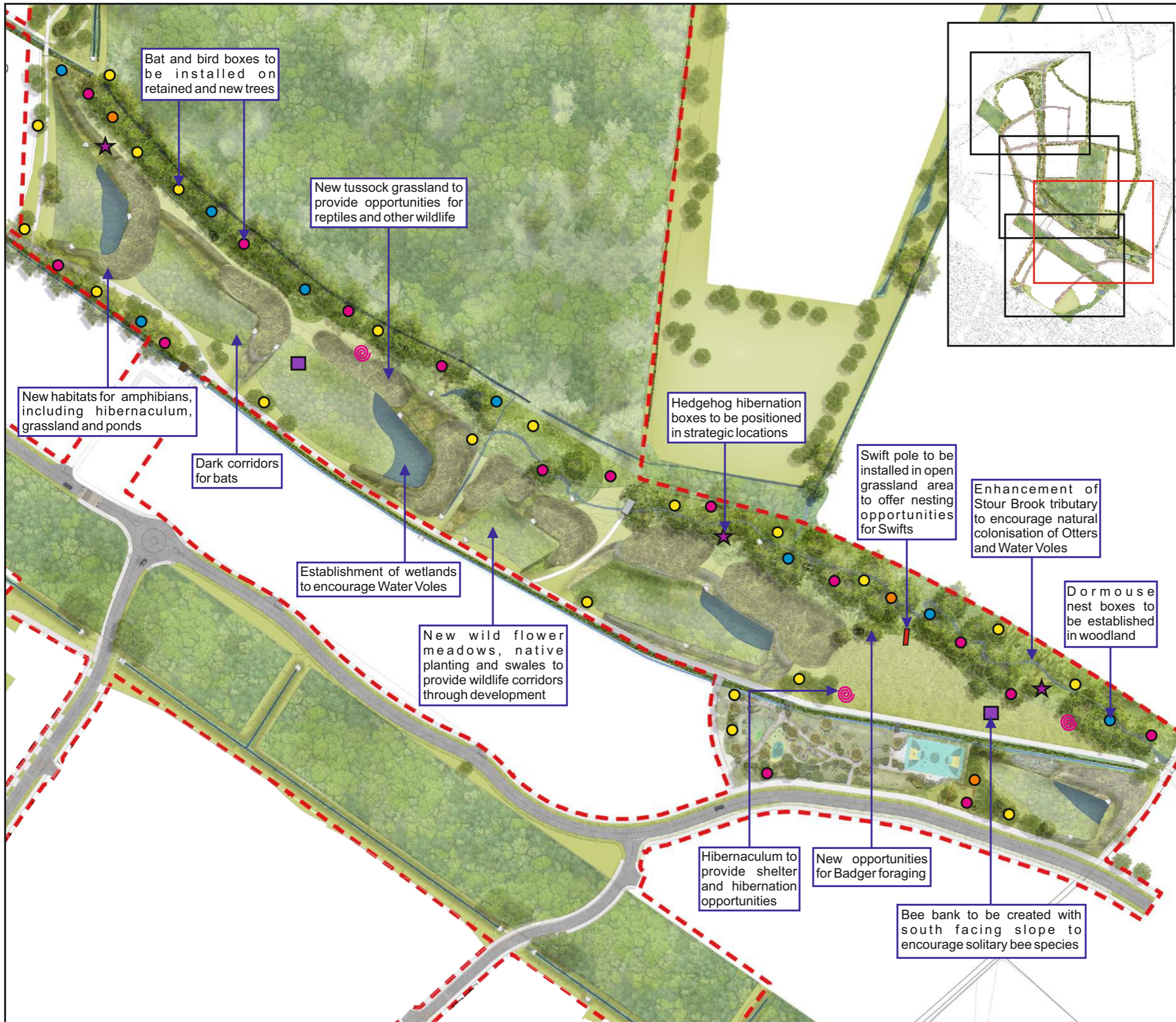

Bat and bird boxes to be installed on retained and new trees

New tussock grassland to provide opportunities for reptiles and other wildlife

New habitats for amphibians, including hibernaculum, grassland and ponds

Dark corridors for bats

Establishment of wetlands to encourage Water Voles

New wild flower meadows, native planting and swales to provide wildlife corridors through development

Hedgehog hibernation boxes to be positioned in strategic locations

Swift pole to be installed in open grassland area to offer nesting opportunities for Swifts

Enhancement of Stour Brook tributary to encourage natural colonisation of Otters and Water Voles









Dormouse nest boxes to be established in woodland

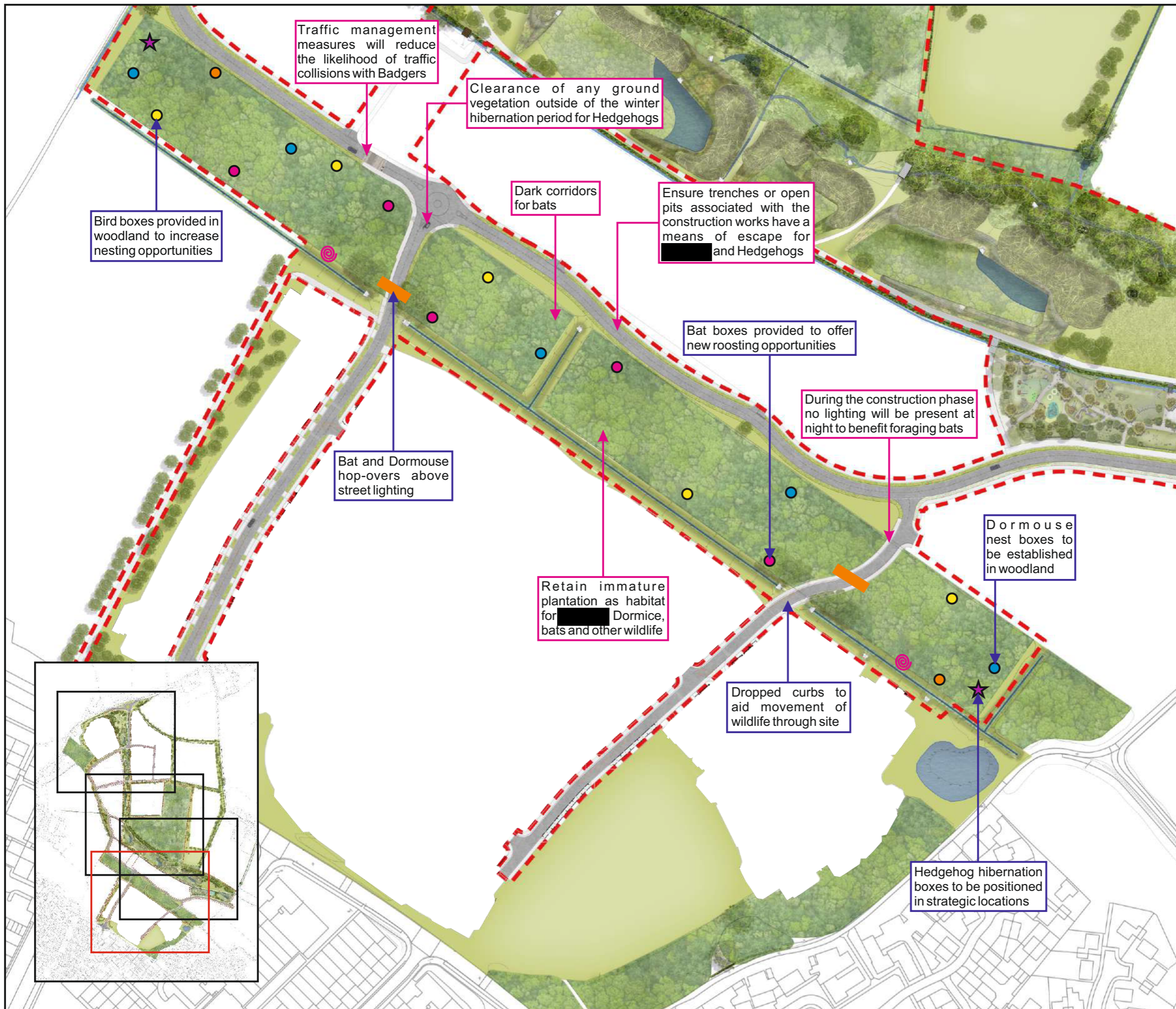




