Comment: My concerns with this proposal is lack of infrastructure. Currently trying to join Wrattling Road from Millfields Way and Kedington of a morning is already a nightmare. The A134 is single carriageway right through to Bury and simply cannot absorb extra traffic that 2500 extra houses would generate. Neither can the road of death the A1307 to Cambridge. Haverhill has no rail line and A134 and A1307 simply cannot cope with the added volume of cars.

The road at Little Wrattling often floods, 2500 new homes will only add to the problem.

Haverhill is already turning into a commuter town with a serious lack of amenities and 2500 new homes will only compound the problem.

When Hanchett Village was built we were promised schools and doctors. Still waiting over a decade later. I did attend the consultation and was given assurances that due to a change in planning laws this would not be allowed to happen. I personally felt this was all a load of flannel and this proposal will go through regardless.
