I wish to register my concerns regarding the proposed development on the grounds that:-

- 5) The development would cause harm to wildlife and the environment.

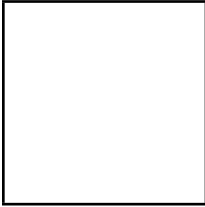
