1 At present as a Little Wratting resident I enjoy a farmers field at the rear of my property. This is going to be used as an extension of Samuel Ward Schools grounds. I'm very concerned that directly outside my premises will be School grounds this will obstruct my views of the countryside and also impede my access to the countryside. Noise levels will also be increased. Also trees would need to be planted to provide privacy to properties if this development goes ahead. A school has recently been built next to Samuel Ward with no trees planted to obscure it from view of nearby properties and it isn't a pleasant sight.
