It is all very well creating more homes for people but if there are no facilities and poor infrastructure it is not fair to encourage people to come to live in Haverhill.

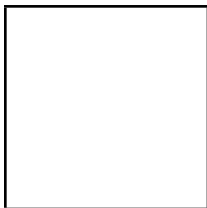
