We received a letter from the Planning Department for The Great Wilsey Park Wilsey Road Little Wrating Suffolk .With Proposals of Revised proposals providing alternative access point to Chalkstone Way at its roundabout Junction with Millfields Way.

We Wish to raise an Objection to this as having a feed through to Millfields Way will create more traffic cutting through our housing estate. Where we live. The heavy traffic vehicals such as Buses and Lorries travelling on this distributor road now. Not only causes much damage to Millfields Way, road surface , but the Vibration and Noise has in past caused damage to our house by way of our render having to be replaced twice the road calming on this road adding to this ,should have been replaced with a different method possibly Chicanes of slowing to replace the old speed humps that enhance the noise and vibration levels. As we have Buses travelling up Millfields Way from 05:15 to 00:35 effecting our sleep as we live road side and our enjoyment of our outdoors space.

The extra traffic Will have an effect on the value of our property we own, and with Millfields way being accessible up to a possible 5,000 Extra Vehicles on average when project complete . We understand this will not be ,the only Access to The Great Wilsey Estate ,but if there is a faster cut through then I'm sure it will be taken advantage of .
