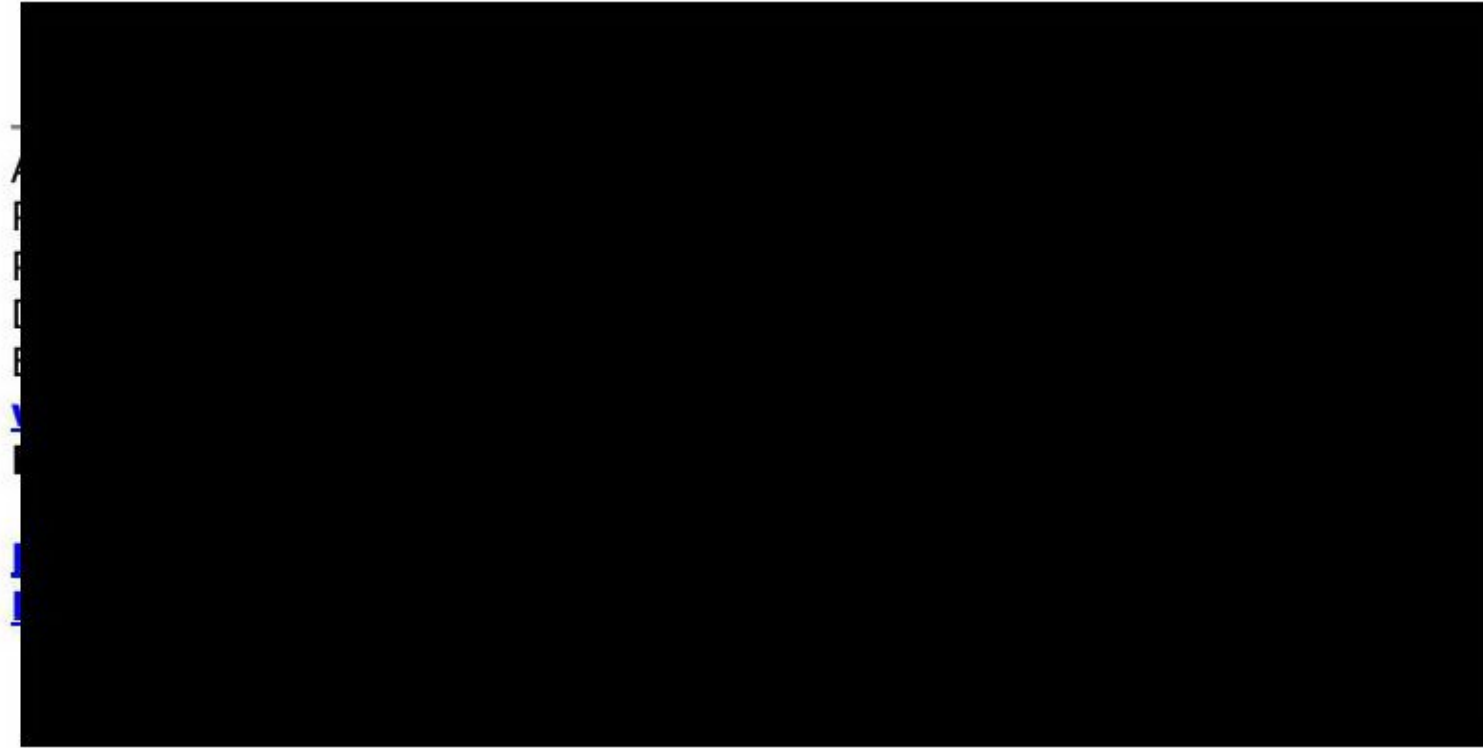

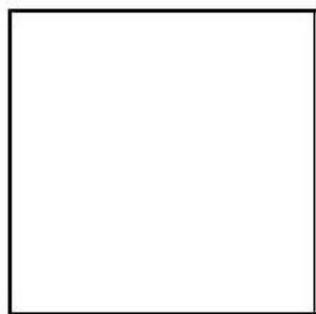
DC/16/2426/RM: Submission of details under Outline Planning Permission DC/15/2424/OUT – security fencing, land at Haverhill Business Park, Bumpstead Road, Haverhill, for Hammond Rutts Investments Ltd.

I thank you for consulting the Ramblers on this application, allegedly affecting a public right of way, taken to be Haverhill fp 13 in the vicinity of plot NE 2, tolerably following the north-eastern site boundary. No fencing appears to be proposed here, so I am unable to comment.

However, I have noted in the past that there is a right of way, (Sturmer fp 24), shown on the Definitive Map for Essex, Braintree District, running tolerably north from Phoenix Road towards Helions Bumpstead Road, but not crossing the county boundary into Suffolk to reach it; the route is between plots NW 1 and NW 2. I have drawn attention to this anomaly previously, in the hope that it will be addressed, but cannot, for the moment, say that the fencing proposed parallel to Helions Bumpstead Road, (in Suffolk), will affect a public right of way.
