Dear Kerri

Following on from our previous emails I have now viewed the revised plan submitted in relation to Unit 3.

Looking at the revised layout for vehicle movements it suggests that the four loading bays nearest Bumpstead Road have been reduced to two, presumably this was to allow for the parking spaces and HGV turning circle. What is not clear from the submitted plan is how this affects the elevations because the building has been built with four bays and two bays as set out drawing number 6502-SK26 D. If the four bays nearest Bumpstead Road remain as constructed it would not appear to allow sufficient space for the parking bays shown on plan 6502-SK19 K. Are the two bays that are not now proposed going to be left in situ or will the elevation change?

In light of this amended application it would that no elevation details have been submitted to concur with the latest submitted plan, can you confirm that the elevation will change and if so how?
