It has come to my attention that there is a plan to connect Ann Suckling Road in Haverhill to the current roundabout in Hales Barn Road thereby changing Ann Suckling from a quiet entry road into the Boyton Hall estate into, effectively, a section of a Haverhill Northern bypass. The effect of the traffic on such a road will destroy the peace of the Boyton hall estate.

When the housing development on the north of Haverhill was first mooted and the planning put up for public discussion, as I recall the planned bypass (or relief road) was to be an entirely new road commencing at the abandoned "Fox" pub on the Haverhill - Bury-st-Edmunds road and skirting the north of the new development completely outside the town to join the Hales Barn roundabout. There appears to have been no public notification of a change in this plan to allow residents to raise objections (at least, I haven't had such notification). That being so, as a resident of Boyton Hall estate, I would like to register my objection to such a change to the route of the relief road.

If I have been misinformed and the plans have not been changed to include Ann Suckling in the relief road, could you please notify me.
