Hi Penny

The Highway Authority have reviewed the proposed phasing arrangements, we note that 98 dwellings (69 private houses and 29 associated housing dwellings) in Phase 6 will be occupied before any alternative carriageway connection to Ann Suckling Road is available.

We have undertaken a highway review to test this scenario and undertaken sensitivity tests to check these results and conclude that Ann Suckling Road and the A143 junction will function within capacity.

We recommend that this is acceptable in highway safety and highway capacity terms.

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
