I'll update design and access statement to include:

- a page on parking strategy and approach, addressing or clarifying mattes raised in the consultant's response.
- a page showing drawing of where bins will be collected from, going through council's waste management approach document it says they collect upto 50m away from the edge of street. So the current storage space shouldn't be an issue as it is within the range. Anyhow we can perhaps present the bins on the both wides of walkway so they are closer to street edge and not obstructing.
