Where does he intend on having all these builders park, equipment, diggers and stores stored ? Muck aways diggers etc etc etc

there's a lovely young family who lives in 54, the gardens going to be a mine field of dangers for the kids...

Let alone the traffic which this road is a seriously busy cut through for the emergency services and lorry's etc it's dangerous at best ! And then when you bring in a developer where the road narrows and there's parking both sides.

The planning still shows he's going to be building right up against our fence at 56 Crowland road in which we will not allow to be taken down or access for scaffolding on our driveway removing our access for parking.
