We note that the proposed development lies a short distance outside the Suffolk county boundary.

We note that CCC Transport Assessment Team have responded to the consultation with a request that additional trip information is provided before a planning decision is made.

We note that CCC Highways Development Management have also requested that further information is provided.

We agree with these approaches and have no further comment about this development at this time.
