There are dangerous problems of which there is the family and their children at 54 who will be living in a building site alarm bells ring! In which they only found out yesterday about the new planning and the access for the neighbours he's removing and giving a slight walk way which hinders them and I presume everyone else will do the same, as from the over building here prospectives and traffic problems including the driveway which is just dangerous where the road narrows and they have no visibility from traffic coming up or down that road.

A thorough site visit needs to be taken out and to fully understand the magnitude of the dangers let alone the problems of this build.
