I have lived at Hanchett House opposite the proposed Anaerobic Digester Plant site, for fifty years. I find it unbelievable that this facility is being planned for the Gateway to Haverhill. With all the local businesses and nearby houses, the stench will be unbearable. With the westerly winds driving it towards Haverhill. The visual impact and noise from the 24/7 operating plant will be catastrophic to me and the local residents.

I have been very ill recently and this will have a huge impact on my health and my family. The increase in slow moving traffic is also a huge concern to me, living adjacent to the a1307.

Over the years living here I have seen countless times how the proposed area severely floods and find it astonishing that something of this scale could be build on such an area. With the type of feedstock that will be travelling into the plant, if any of this should get into the water course then I dread to think what the consequences would be.

I have previously worked on a site like this as a lorry driver, and know first hand exactly how drastic the smell is and simply cannot contemplate the fact I might have to live next to one.
