Dear Mr Rutter,

I am writing to you to express my concerns over the proposed Anaerobic Digester plant at spring grove farm.

I live just a few hundred yards away from the site and haven't looked into the information given by acorn and other research, I find the the situation unimaginable. The fact of building such a site so close to residential areas is quite baffling. I cannot comprehend the impact that the "150" extra lorries/tractors-trailers would have on what is already a high casualty road. Having lived here all my life I have seen first hand how dangerous the road can be, many things have been put in place to try and improve the road safety. However with this added traffic, especially all being HGVs what impact is this going to have. Our driveway is directly opposite the proposed A.D plant entrance, and it is hard enough now to try pulling out onto the A1307. I have three young children who all attend school, which in turn means we have to exit on to this road during peak traffic times. Which as I say is already a nightmare.

Secondly the reported odours from the plant are deeply worrying for myself and my family. I fear this would have a daily impact on our life.

All in all the proposed location of a site of this purpose and magnitude seems quite ridiculous. I understand that these types of enterprises need to exist, but to have one so close to a town just isn't plausible.

I sincerely hope my concerns will be taken into account and that common sense will prevail.
