Objection - SCC/0045/23SE

The silage and poultry waste plant proposed by Acorn Energy for Withersfield, near Haverhill, will negatively impact the surrounding area. As a former resident of Haverhill with close family in the town I object to this proposal which will blight the countryside and the lives of people living in a sizeable radius of the site.

The plant, while providing negligible economic benefit to West Suffolk, will create smells that will travel across Haverhill (population c27,000) and surrounding villages. It will also create noise, a negative visual impact on the landscape and will generate greatly increased HGV and gas tanker movements on poor road infrastructure. There are real water pollution risks as the site frequently floods.
