I am writing regarding the planning application No: SSC/0045/23SE for the anaerobic digestion facility of which I strongly object to. I feel the proposed site is in totally the wrong location, far too close to Haverhill and it's surrounding villages, houses, schools, shops and in turn affecting people's right to breathe clean air. Road safety would be greatly compromised with increased HGV's and heavy farm machinery going in and out of the site, causing a huge carbon footprint and extra risk of collisions.

I feel our wildlife would suffer with more road deaths as a result of the inevitable use of our village roads. The point that concerns me the most is awful smell we will be subjected to all year round with global warming and hot summers. I feel this will be intolerable and will reduce air quality with Methane (CH4) and Carbon Dioxide (CO2) to name but a few being released into the atmosphere. With the site being so close to houses this WILL be detrimental to people's lives!

I also believe this will increase the risk of flooding with rain running off I presume a very large area of concrete onto land that is already at risk of flooding.
