Thank you for requesting advice on this application from Place Services' arboricultural advice services. This provides advice to planning officers to inform West Suffolk Council planning decisions with regard to potential arboricultural impacts from development. Background

An application was submitted to West Suffolk Council for the above property for consent to carry out the following works:

Planning application - change of use and construction of second floor extension to existing public house to create nine flats (class C3 and three commercial units (class E)

Comments

The supporting evidence clearly identifies that T1 Sycamore (Cat C) requires complete removal, which is acceptable given a clear provision of G1, G2, and G3.

Therefore, permission is supported subject to the condition that submission of a Tree Protection Plan (TPP) in accordance with BS5837:2012, evidencing the retained G1, G2, G3 with tree protection barriers located outside of the RPA, for the approval by the LPA.
